

Write a description of the rainforest using expanded noun phrases (the bright green treetops) and suffixes (words ending in -ly, -ment, -ness, -ful). You could even write a story about a rainforest adventure!

Research an animal that lives in a tropical rainforest and make a poster or a fact file about it. You could include a title, images from the internet, drawn illustrations, heading, sub-headings, labels and captions. Try to add some questions too!

Places near the equator, like the Amazon, have hot climates. Can you find out about somewhere in the world that is far from the equator and has a cold climate? What is it like?

Where in the World have you travelled to? You can make a video or a scrap book sharing your adventures. Or, why not tell us about a place you would love to visit and why.

Spelling challenge: chameleon, jaguar, orangutan, piranha, endangered, vegetation, deforestation, camouflage, extinct, pungent, equator, hemisphere.

Parents- Please feel free to adapt these tasks to suit your child and present them in any way that you choose. The homework on this grid is not compulsory although we do encourage the children to complete some of the tasks as this supports their learning in class.
