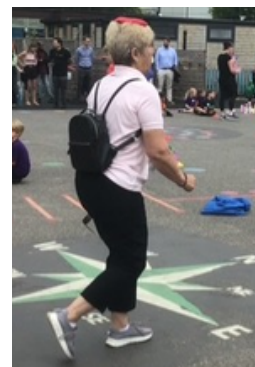
Sports Day Fun!
